End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Ingenico i5310 and i5100 Desktop Payment Terminals in North America

With Ingenico's launch and transition to its next generation Telium 2 payment devices, this product announcement serves as an official notification that the U32 based i5310 and i5100 Desktop Payment Terminals will reach their end-of-sale (EOS) and end-of-life (EOL) milestones in North America on the dates listed below. Customers with active service contacts will continue to receive warranties and services support from Ingenico as specified by terms and conditions in their contracts through December 31, 2014. | The Last Buy | The last date to order the device through Ingenico. This is the final forecast due date for these devices with the PO's due on March 31, 2012. | December 31, 2011 |
| Last Ship Date | The last possible ship date that can be requested of Ingenico. | March 31, 2012 |
| Last Date of Support | The last date to receive support for the device. All customers should refer to the specific warranties and service agreement purchased to determine the level of maintenance and support they are entitled to for the device during the EOL period. | December 31, 2014 |
