1_Announcement

The purpose of this notice is to advise that Ingenico North America is announcing a withdrawal from marketing and sale of the PCI-PTS v2.x models of the iCT220 and iCT250 in both the USA and Canada.

Please note that all revisions within said part numbers are included in this notice. For example, ICT220-01P1218 includes ICT220-01P1218A, ICT220-01P1218B, etc.

2_Rationale

Payment devices (hardware) and POS applications (software) are evolving technologies. They follow a natural product life cycle. Payment hardware is primarily governed by the Payment Card Industry Security Standards Council's (PCI SSC) regulatory compliance requirements, in addition to market activity and market demand.

Ingenico North America is taking the action to EOL the iCT220 and iCT250 products listed above due to the impending PCI-PTS v2.x expiration on April 30th, 2017. This expiration date is consistent for any and all PCI-PTS v2.x products, regardless of manufacturer.

After the expiration date, Ingenico is unable to sell or ship any new products to customers. However, Ingenico may continue to repair said products and provide software updates as required.

These services will be provided on a “best-efforts” basis based on existing stock or parts. No new parts will be procured after the EOS date.
